

Dr. Erin Morley is an academic general internist and UBC Clinical Assistant Professor at Vancouver General Hospital (VGH). She completed her medical school training at UBC as a Wesbrook scholar. Her undergraduate training and fellowship took place at UBC in General Internal Medicine, with focused fellowship training at McMaster University in Perioperative Cardiovascular Medicine.

Dr. Morley has been extensively involved in initiating and growing the VGH perioperative medicine service.
